Dear Parents/ Guardians

1. KC Open House

KC will be having our Open House on **Saturday, 22 November** from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Beyond reaching out to prospective students and parents, the Open House is a platform for the girls to showcase their interests and talents, and for them to hone important skills such as leadership, organization and communication. 2. School Operations during School Vacation Period

Students who are returning to school for lessons, CCA and consultations should be properly attired in their uniform with school shoes and socks. Students and parents/guardians who wish to meet school personnel should make prior appointments as they may not be in school. The General Office will be closed at 12 p.m. on **Tuesday, 11 November**. From **Monday, 24 November**, the General Office will operate from 7.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. every workday during the school holidays.

3. Sale of Textbooks and Uniform for Academic Year 2026

Sec 2 students progressing to Sec 3 should only purchase their textbooks after confirmation of their Sec 3 subject combination. a. Start of Academic Year 2026

b. MOE-OBS Challenge for 2026 Sec 3 Students
