3. Administrative Matters

a. Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA)

The school documents events and programmes with photographs and videos, which could be published on the school's media platforms and publications (both online and hard copy). Students also take class photos which are published in the School Annual and distributed to them as a keepsake. We seek your consent on the use of your daughter's/ward's photographs and videos on such medium, which will be in force for the years of your daughter's/ward's stay in KC. Please click "Yes", at the bottom of the notification, for consent and "No" for non-consent. If we do not receive a response from you by **Monday, 22 January 2024**, it will be taken as consent.

4. Safety & Security Matters

a. Personal and Social Responsibility

To ensure that the school remains a safe place for teaching and learning, students who are unwell should seek medical attention and stay away from school. Schools conduct Temperature Taking Exercises twice a year to enable students to learn to take their own temperature as part of exercising personal and social responsibility, and to be prepared against threats posed by diseases. For Semester 1, the Temperature Taking Exercise will be conducted on Wednesday, 10 January. Students have been informed to bring a working thermometer on that day.

b. Road Safety

Drop Off

You may drive into the school to drop off your daughter/ ward between 6.45am and 7.15am, and beyond 7.15am for inclement weather. Otherwise, please allow your daughter/ ward to alight from the vehicle safely and promptly outside the school. As enforced by Traffic Police, drivers should not make a right turn when exiting the school between 6.45am and 7.15am.

Pick-up

For dismissal pick-up within the school, you may drive into the school only after 3.00pm. Waiting or parking in school is not allowed. Alternatively, you may wish to wait for your daughter/ward at one of the public carparks opposite the school.

Pedestrians Safety

The students have been instructed to use the pedestrian crossings at Marine Terrace. We would like to urge all drivers to drive safely, especially during peak hours, to keep our students and other road-users safe.

c. Visiting the School

The school puts in place the following guidelines for visitors to ensure the safety of students:

Visitor Appointments

Please make a prior appointment with the school personnel you plan to meet and register at the security counter upon arrival. If you are driving, we seek your understanding to park at the public carpark opposite the school.

Parents'/ Guardians' Access Areas

Parents'/ Guardians are requested to keep to the lower foyer and the bookshop. During term time, you may visit the bookshop between 2.00pm and 3.30pm. There shall be no access to other areas of the school unless arrangements have been made for you to do so.
